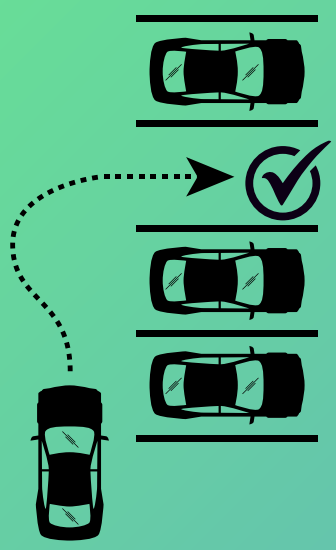

Parking is prohibited on all city streets between 2:00am to 6:00am. In a hardship case you are able to apply for a parking permit.



Ordinance NO. 5-30 & 5-4

Join us on Saturday, **September 20th** for the return of the Black Jack Fall Festival – a community favorite packed with good vibes and great times!

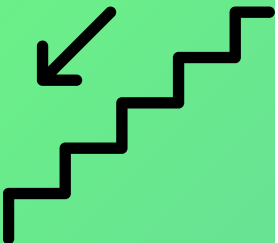
